Dear Friends,

A warm welcome to St. Andrew's Parish Community!

We are a vibrant, welcoming and diverse Roman Catholic Community. We gather around, and in the name of Jesus Christ with whom and through whom we worship and celebrate the Sacraments. We are really happy that you and your family be part of this parish. All staff and visitors, follow strict protocols to keep your child in the safest environment.

Goals of the Program

St Andrew's parish religious education program aims to assist you, the parents, in your role as the first religious educator of your child.

All people are created "in the image and likeness of God", as a result of this, we are restless and learning to fulfil a natural yearning and desires to rest spiritually in our God. As baptized Catholic, we are initiation into the Christian community, which carries with it a continuing need to grow in understanding of and participation in the faith, that gives us spiritual life. Hence every young Christian, by reason of humanity and baptism, has a claim religious education.

Duty of Care

These protocols to keep your child 's safety first.

1. Classes commence at 4pm and finish at 5pm.
2. Supervision will commence 10 minutes before and finish 10 after class. All children must be dropped off and picked up promptly with in these times.
3. It is the responsibility of the parents to drop off and pick up promptly with in these times. It is the responsibility of the parents to supervise your child before and after these times.
4. The parents are to drop off and pick up your child from the parish house meeting rooms where supervision will be maintained.
5. Two volunteers will supervise the children during the duty of care.
6. Your child is to be signed in and out by a parent or guardian every Tuesday that your child's class is running. However, this is not required when you and your child are attending reflection day, workshops and Masses together.

St. Andrew's Religious Education Program

Enrolment

Enrolling your child shows us that you are eager about the RE program and that you are committed to attend all after school classes and workshops / Masses run with in the program.

Fees
